## Spiritual Director's Notes

Sunday I was watching the race from Talladega. It is one of the super speedways and they use restrictor plates on the engines so the cars are limited in the ability to get away from one another. They basically run in packs two and three wide pushing each other, forming large lines that help them move easier around the track and have the ability to move to the front.

Track position is important. Do you want to be in the front or the back? No one really wants to be in middle with the huge crowd. Why? Sooner or later the big one is going to happen. The big one is the wreck that will take out a large number of cars at once. Sunday there were two big ones. The second one with fewer than twenty laps to go took out 10 cars, and six of the cars where in the top 12 in points. One of them was my driver, Dale Earnhardt, Jr., who was at the wrong place at the wrong time. He had the wrong track position.

Position is also important in our Christian walk. Being in the wrong position can cause us a lot of grief as we battle the enemy. It is important to know what our position is, and the second Chapter of Ephesians tells us that Christ is seated in the heavenly places. It also tells us that we are seated in the heavenly places with Christ. It does not say we will be seated, but rather we are seated in the heavenly realm. That is the position that our Christian walk proceeds from. It is from this position that we are given the authority of Christ. Jesus said, if we have the faith of a mustard seed we can say to this mountain to be cast into the sea and it will happen. The prayer of authority comes from our position in Christ. It is the promise of this position that enables the prayer of faith that moves mountains. Let us walk our fourth day in the assurance that Jesus was raised from the dead and ascended into heaven. In heaven he is seated in authority and we are seated with him. Thanks be to God.

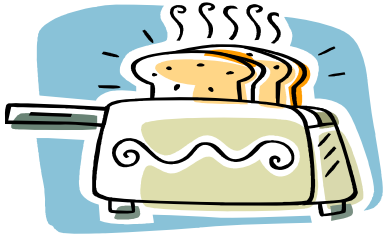

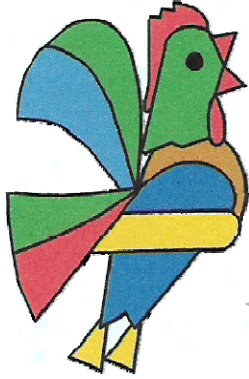
